
## Understanding Portal Hypertension and Varices

### Results measure risk to make procedural decisions

- For **LOW risk**, your doctor may choose to forgo endoscopy and recommend lifestyle changes, prescribe medicine or alternative care planning
- For **HIGHER risk**, your doctor may choose to check for esophageal varices with endoscopy

### Results assess your risk for portal hypertension and varices

- With a scarred or damaged liver (cirrhosis), risk of **portal hypertension** (high blood pressure in the vein around the liver) may increase
- Risk of complications may increase if **esophageal varices** occur when veins swell and become fragile
- Varices under high pressure are more likely to burst and bleed

### Results help your doctor understand shunting

- Shunting** happens when blood that normally flows through the liver is redirected, or "shunted," around the liver.
- Can lead to fluid in belly and swollen legs and feet, and confusion and memory problems.
- When blood skips the liver, risk of fluid in the belly, legs, and feet and memory problems increases
